MSST 476.001 Museum Collection Management

Catalog Description

Method, theory, and practice of collection management, including acquisitions, law, ethics, organization, storage and retrieval, environmental controls, security, stabilization, risk management, and data management.

Prerequisite: 407 or ARTH 407.

Detailed Course Description

This course introduces students to underlying principals, method and theory, and the practice of collection management in museums today. A wide range of topics – including acquisitions, museum law, ethics, collection organization, data management, object storage, environmental controls, collection use, and risk management – will serve as the focus of weekly readings, discussions, and presentations in online format. The course will emphasize the breadth of information and practical skills that museum professionals rely upon to carry out their work.
