UNM Online stipends are available for all courses that successfully complete a Foundational Course Design Review, including newly developed online courses and courses which have been previously offered online. To be eligible for a review stipend:

- Course must be developed in collaboration with the Center for Teaching & Learning. The IBOC must meet at least once with their assigned instructional designer to be eligible for a Foundational Course Design Review.
- Course must adhere to the UNM Online Excellence Framework: <https://ctl.unm.edu/onlineframework/>
- Course development must be based on the Foundational Course Design Elements and any applicable Special Considerations from the UNM Online Learning Excellence Framework.
- Courses must adhere to federal regulations on [Regular and Substantive Interaction](#) and [Web Content Accessibility Level 2 Guidelines](#) (WCAG). Regular and Substantive Interaction (RASI) training is accessed through [Learning Central](#).
- Distribution of review stipends to instructors is at the discretion of both the college and the IBOC's department. Consult with your department regarding payment methods before requesting a Foundational Course Design Review as policies around stipend payouts vary among colleges/schools.
- The stipend is transferred to the IBOC's college/school upon successful completion of the Foundational Course Design Review and implementation of all required changes.
